POLICY STATEMENT

OBJECTIVES

Assured Environmental Services has a legal responsibility to maintain a safe working environment by adhering to the points set out below and by noting Health & Safety policy statements relevant to wherever work is being carried out.

- To maintain all plant and equipment in a safe manner
- To wear appropriate PPE for work being carried out as required by statute and good practice
- To ensure that Emergency Aid Training is kept up to date by maintaining a current Emergency Aid Certificate issued by a recognised organisation
- To maintain a Contractors Passport to Safety certificate
- To follow safe operating practices and procedures including
 1. Being continually aware of environmental changes occurring (especially with regard to fly control of LFS)
 2. Using all pesticides and other substances as per manufacturers recommendations
 3. Providing risk assessments and method statements on request
 4. Being aware of other site users
 5. Ensuring that any special instructions are notified to the person concerned via the treatment report sheet left on site after each treatment
